floodplain splay. A small alluvial fan or other outspread deposit formed where an overloaded stream breaks through a levee (artificial or natural) and deposits its material (often coarse-grained) on the floodplain. Syn: *overbank splay; sand splay; channel splay; splay [geomorph]*.
