burial metamorphism. A type of low-grade regional metamorphism affecting sediments and interlayered volcanic rocks in a geosyncline without any influence of orogenesis or magmatic intrusion. Original rock fabrics are largely preserved but mineralogical compositions are generally changed (Coombs, 1961). Cf: *dynamothermal metamorphism*.
