erosion caldera. A type of *caldera* that is developed by the erosion and resultant widening of a caldera or by erosion of a volcanic cone, resulting in a large, central circulike depression. It is considered by some not to be a true caldera type, since it is not formed by volcanic processes. Cf: *explosion caldera; collapse caldera.*
