NOAA - The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration in concert with the Department of Commerce announced their intent to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement regarding expansion of the Flower Garden Banks National Marine Sanctuary. [Tuesday, February 3, 2015 (Volume 80, Number 22)]

FEMA - Notice of declaration of a major disaster for the Soboba Indians resulting from severe storms, flooding, and mudslides that occurred December 4-6th, 2014. [Wednesday, February 4, 2015 (Volume 80, Number 23)]

FEMA - The Department of Homeland Security and Federal Emergency Management Agency request comments on proposed new flood hazard determinations. Comments must be submitted on or before May 11th. [Monday, February 9, 2015 (Volume 80, Number 26)]

DOI - The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management announced it will open and publicly announce bid for blocks offered in CPA Sale 235 for oil and gas in the Gulf of Mexico at 9am on Wednesday March 18th. [Friday, February 6, 2015 (Volume 80, Number 25)]

DOI - The Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement in conjunction with the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management proposed rules for future oil and gas offshore drilling in the Arctic. DOI - The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management announced availability of a final supplemental environmental impact statement for offshore Arctic leases sold in 2008.
