hardness points . Small, pointed pieces of minerals of different hardness, affixed to handles and used for testing the hardness of another mineral by ascertaining which point will scratch it. Minerals of hardness 6 to 10 on the Mohs scale are usually used as the points for testing gemstones. Because of the potential for damage, this test is not routinely used on faceted gemstones.
