## **Oil Reservoirs and Traps in the Albertine Rift of Uganda**

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The Miocene reservoir sands of the northern Albert Rift were deposited in a fluvial system that entered the graben from the NE and flowed SW. The spatial and temporal evolution of that system can be delineated from well and seismic data.

Oil is trapped in the reservoir sands following updip migration from the source rock. Patterns in the configuration of oil pools show the geological controls trap integrity.

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
