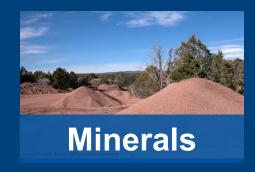

Types of Information Products



Factsheets: short, clearly written, and scientifically rigorous introductions to a range of topics.



Case Studies: specific examples of how research in the geosciences is being applied to the decision-making process, especially at the state and local level.





Maps & Visualizations:

collection of interactive maps and visualizations that has been curated from federal and state agencies, including state geological surveys.

Frequent Questions:

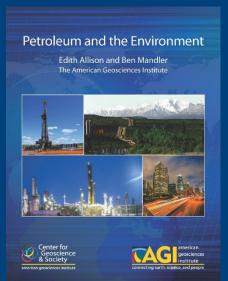
answers to common questions about geoscience topics.

Webinars: recorded events that highlight the application of geoscience to state and local issues.



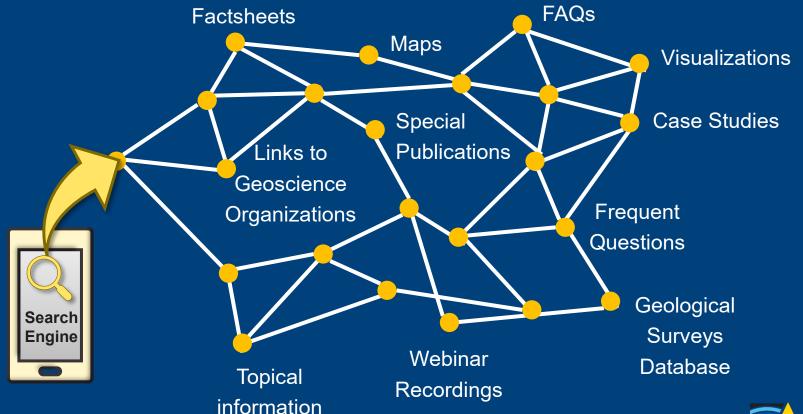
Special Publications: AGI publications that cover a range of geoscience topics and applications.

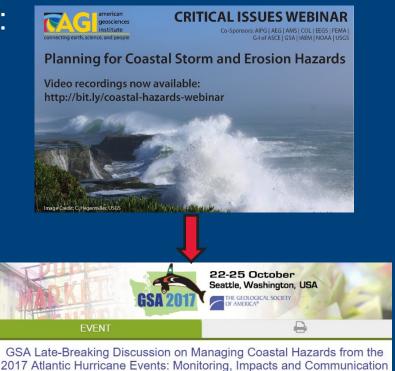




Usage of the Critical Issues Platform

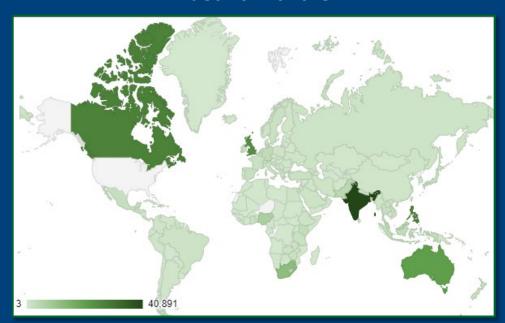
