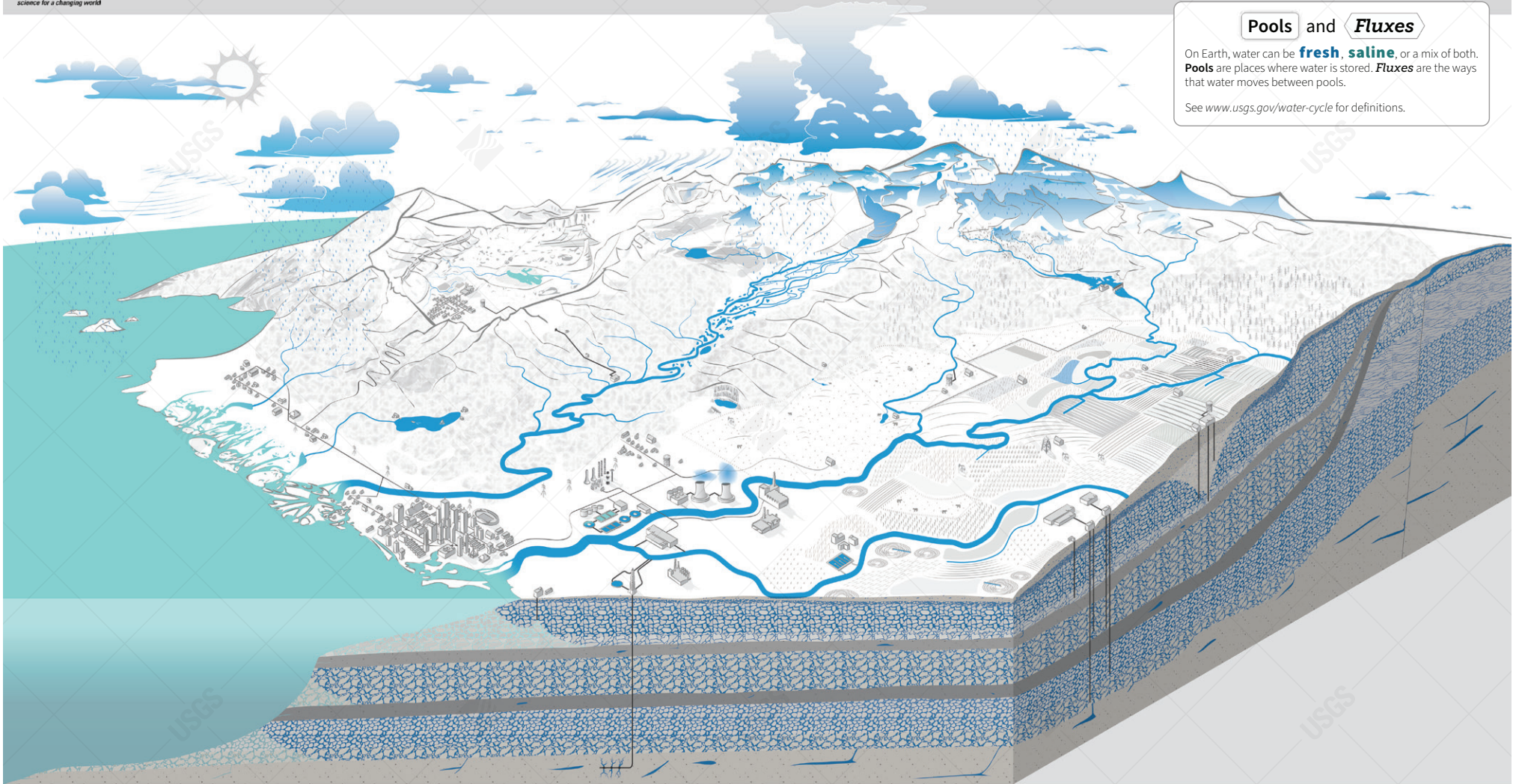


Pools and **Fluxes**
